Agenda:

- Garbage and dumping- BBIA will be participating in the City forum dealing with the issues of waste management in the industrial, *commercial* and institutional sectors on September 21st and will report the results of the meeting.
- Extensive cost related to Graffiti removal- Revisit pooling of resources towards security patrolling of commercial property based on the **\$10,000 grant** to be provided to the BBIA should the City's Graffiti Management Strategy commence in January 2008.
- Timing of roadwork on road expansion of Woodroffe and Strandherd widenings; update on progress and wrap up;
 - i. Access in/out malls particularly to 4 lane thruways and impact on tenants of road widening/median work
- Development/Planning issues related to appearance and signage on cornerstones- BBIA has access to grants and funding and would like further discussion about what and where to begin the implementation of a full Barrhaven cornerstone program.
- BBIA proposed service to match vacancies with prospective tenants; currently, have a list of your vacancies on our website. Is there anything more we can do to assist with filling vacancies with suitable tenants?
