



Strandherd Drive Widening Public Open House, April 12, 2007 Comments and Notes

The following is a list of notes compiled from observation of the Design and Construction Proposals and discussion with the City engineers in attendance;

- RioCan to Crestway segment to commence in June 2007 and be completed by the end of 2007
- Underpass into MarketPlace Mall for the S/W Transit Corridor extension. Design work has been approved and construction will start in the fall of 2008. This will be a 2 year project. (Which will tear up the existing 4 lanes of Strandherd)
- The mall at Longfields and Strandherd, 3570 Strandherd, will permanently lose its left-out turn. No access to East bound lanes out of the exit. Must exit through the Esso gas station and go through the lights at Longfields to access Strandherd eastbound lanes.
- New traffic lights to be put up at both Claridge and Beatrice on Strandherd.
- Winner of the Strandherd contract will also construct the new major intersection at Woodroffe (also to be 4 lanes).
- Crestway to Prince of Wales extension has been put on hold until the transit issue is addressed.
- Tender will be awarded based on best price. Winner will provide their terms of construction and staging of the project. **BBIA will review this staging and submit comments to the Engineer, Carolyn Newcombe, for consideration of the following; times of day for activity, phasing of the work, closing of sections, blocking of access to malls, etc.** City has some ability once the staging is received to make changes with the contractor prior to the commencement of construction.
