Strandherd Drive Widening From Rio Can Avenue to Crestway Drive

Detailed Design and Construction Proposals

A Preliminary and Detailed Design assignment has been carried out to widen and extend Strandherd Drive between Greenbank Road and Prince of Wales Drive.

This project received environmental clearance through the completion of an Environmental Study Report in 1993 (Rideau River Bridge, Location Feasibility Study, Strandherd Drive/Armstrong Road, January 1993 and an ESR Addendum November 1997). The initial phase of construction was completed in 2000.

Earlier Public Open Houses were held on this project on June 6, 2006 and November 9, 2006.

The current assignment between Rio Can Avenue and Crestway Drive, will provide the City with tender documents by the end of April 2007, permitting tendering and construction to proceed during the 2007 construction season.

The following main items have been included within the proposed 2007 construction:

- Widening of Strandherd from two lanes to four lanes between Rio Can Avenue and Crestway Drive.
- Construction of a new storm sewer between Longfields Drive and Prince of Wales Drive (connecting to an existing storm sewer).
- Modifications to the existing traffic control signal system and street lighting system.
- Private utility modifications and relocations, as required.
- Landscaping of the road boulevards.
